7-Belong (v) Meaning: to be the property of someone, to be connected to, to be a member of



Sentence: This book **belongs**



to Sarah.

Sentence: He feels like he

truly **belongs** to this

community.

8- Suppose (v) Meaning: to think that something is true, to expect, to understand





Sentence: The manager

supposes an increase in

orders.

Sentence: He supposed it's

time to go home.

8- Realize (v) Meaning: to become aware of something, to understand, to to know, to think



Sentence: I realized I forgot



my keys.

Sentence: She didn't realize

how late it was.

10- Prefer (v) Meaning: to like one thing more than another, to choose, to pick, to select







Sentence: I prefer tea over

coffee.

Sentence: She prefers to stay

home on holidays.
